Personal information we collect and hold

Information about the users

- User personal information (names, email addresses)
- Account actions and usage stats, such as login and logout requests

Information about the school

- Staff personal information (names, email addresses, identification numbers)
- Student personal information (names, email addresses, date of birth, genders, language backgrounds, ATSI status, identification numbers), academic data, attendance data, wellbeing data, behavioural data, pastoral care data.

How we collect and hold personal information

Collection methods

- Integrations with other platforms, including SIS and LMS systems
- File imports
- Requesting a demonstration of our platform via our website

Holding

- All information is stored onshore in Australia in compliance certified data centres

Disclosure of personal information to overseas recipients
